### **Call for CVs to build a consultants' database on Gender and Development**

The Ethiopia Canada Cooperation Office (ECCO) is seeking to identify consultants (individuals) with substantial gender equality expertise to build ECCO's gender equality consultants' database. The database will be used to identify consultants for various pieces of gender equality work ECCO may need to commission. CVs will only be included in the database for candidates that have a Masters in Gender Studies, Social Sciences or a related field with a minimum of 10 years of experience in gender and development. Particular areas of gender equality expertise sought by ECCO include:

- 1. Food Security and Agricultural Growth (including nutrition, value chains, market linkages etc.)**
- 2. Private Sector Development/Economic Empowerment**
- 3. Justice/Enabling support to government institutions and CSOs**

The individual must have experience in providing gender equality related consultancy services in one or more of the following areas:

- a. Research and policy analysis**
- b. Literature Review**
- c. Project/Program Design**
- d. Monitoring and evaluations (undertaking baseline surveys, monitoring implementation, mid-term and final impact evaluations, writing case stories, etc.)**
- e. Capacity Building (both individual and organizational)**
  - i. Conducting institutional capacity analysis (Gender Audit)
  - ii. Developing gender strategies
  - iii. Producing gender sensitive tools
  - iv. Providing Training
  - v. Providing Mentorship
- f. Development of manuals (Gender mainstreaming manual, Gender training manual, etc...)**
- g. Or any other gender related work**
