The **Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA)** in Addis Ababa is currently seeking a Private Sector Development Advisor to provide support to CIDA's Program in Ethiopia. The contract duration is 12 months, with possibility of extension.

The Private Sector Development Advisor:

- undertakes detailed analysis and provides expert advice to CIDA about key private sector development related issues, policies, trends, challenges and processes in Ethiopia;
- provides analysis and advice on opportunities for CIDA to contribute to the private sector development agenda in Ethiopia;
- provides expert technical advice on the design, planning, and implementation of CIDA private sector development projects in Ethiopia;
- provides assessments and advice about the ongoing performance of CIDA private sector development initiatives, including results achievement, implementation challenges and lessons learned;
- participates in policy dialogue with, and provides policy and technical advice to, government, donors, joint working groups and other stakeholders on private sector development.

Candidates must meet the following ***Mandatory Requirements***:

- Masters degree from a recognized university in business administration, economics, or other field related to private sector development.
- Minimum of 10 years of relevant experience working in the area of private sector development in an Ethiopian or international context.
