ENVIRONMENT ADVISOR

The **Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA)**'s Ethiopia-Canada Cooperation Office (ECCO) in Addis Ababa is currently seeking an Environment Advisor to provide support to CIDA's Program in Ethiopia. The contract duration is 12 months, with possibility of extension.

The Environment Advisor:

- Provides expert technical advice on the design, planning, implementation, monitoring and reporting of CIDA's programs in Ethiopia.
- Conducts and reviews environmental assessments of development programs and projects in Ethiopia.
- Participates in policy dialogue with, and provides policy advice to, government, donors and other stakeholders on sustainable environment and natural resource management.
- Provides capacity building and training on sustainable environment and natural resource management.
- Conducts environment-related research and analysis.

Candidates must meet the following *minimum mandatory criteria*:

- Master degree from a recognized university in environment or a related field
- Minimum of 10 years of experience in environment or related field in or on Africa

Note: Related fields include natural resource management, sustainable land management, soil and water conservation, food security, and agriculture.
